Directions:

SHAKE CAN WELL BEFORE AND DURING USE. Spray in a well-ventilated area away from heat, sparks, or open flame. Spray uniformly on surface to be lubricated. For greater accuracy, or when working in tight areas, use the attached extension tube. AFTER USING PRODUCT, ALWAYS CLEAR SPRAY NOZZLE BY INVERTING CAN AND SPRAYING FOR A FEW SECONDS UNTIL VALVE AND NOZZLE ARE CLEAR.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

DANGER: Extremely flammable aerosol. Pressurized container: may burst if heated. May be fatal if swallowed and enters airways, May cause drowsiness or dizziness. Causes skin irritation. Causes eye irritation.

FIRST AID:

EYE CONTACT: Check for and remove contact lenses. Immediately flush eyes with water for a minimum of 15 minutes keeping eyelids open. Consult a doctor if any irritation occurs.

SKIN CONTACT: Remove contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15-20 minutes. Consult a poison control center or physician immediately.

INHALATION: If inhaled, remove to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration and obtain immediate medical assistance.

INGESTION: Ingestion is unlikely to occur. If swallowed, do not induce vomiting because of risk of aspiration into the lungs. If aspiration is suspected obtain immediate medical attention.

STORAGE: Store locked up. Pressurized container. Protect from sunlight and do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C (122°F). Do not puncture, incinerate, or crush. Do not handle or store near an open flame, heat or other sources of ignition. Store away from incompatible materials.
