Directions:

IMPORTANT: NOT TO BE USED FOR HEAD GASKETS OR CARBURETOR BASE.

1. Remove old gasket.
2. Use a non-flammable cleaner such as Well Worth's BRAKE AWAY Brake Cleaner to remove all oil and grease. Make certain surface is clean and dry.
3. Hold nozzle at 45° angle and with even pressure, draw a bead (1/16" to 1/8" wide) in any direction.
4. Using a clean dry cloth or knife, wipe away any excess RTV Silicone.
5. Wait 15 minutes for bead to skin before re-assembling parts. Make sure parts are properly aligned the first time. Don't over tighten bolts.

IMPORTANT: TO SELF CLOSE CAN, ALWAYS ALLOW ½" OF BEAD IT!™ TO EXTEND PAST STEM OPENING. ON NEXT USE, PULL UPWARD TO REMOVE CURED PLUG FROM STEM.
