Directions:

Shake can well before using.

For New Batteries: Be sure terminals are attached to battery prior to treating. Hold can 10-12 inches from area to be treated. Spray LIFE GUARD+TM on battery terminals and cables. For best results, spray two thin coats on terminals.

For Old Batteries: Use Well Worth's KLEENSEEKTM battery cleaner to completely remove any corrosion buildup first. After all surfaces are clean, follow treatment procedure for new batteries.

KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN

STORAGE: Store in a well-ventilated place. Keep cool. Store locked up. Protect from sunlight. Do not expose to temperatures exceeding 50°C/122°F.

DANGER: Extremely flammable aerosol. Causes serious eye irritation. May cause drowsiness or dizziness. Pressurized container: may burst if heated.

PREVENTION: Keep away from heat, hot surfaces, sparks, open flame and other ignition sources. No smoking. Do not spray on an open flame or other ignition source. Ground/bond container and receiving equipment. Use explosion-proof electrical/ventilating/lighting/equipment. Use only non-sparking tools. Take precautionary measures against static discharge. Do not pierce or burn, even after use. Avoid breathing dust/fume/gas/mist/vapours/spray. Wash skin thoroughly after handling. Use only outdoors or in a well-ventilated area. Wear protective gloves/protective clothing/eye protection/ face protection.

FIRST AID: IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: Get medical advice/attention. IF INGESTED: Call a POISON CENTER or doctor/physician if you feel unwell. Do NOT induce vomiting.

IN CASE OF FIRE: Use dry sand, dry chemical or alcohol-resistant foam for extinction.

DISPOSAL: Dispose of contents/container to an approved waste disposal plant.
