



WHEEL & PAINT CLEANER



Use Wheel & Paint Cleaner before mechanical decontamination (clay bar, etc.) to remove metal surface contaminants, brake dust and embedded iron particles. When sprayed onto surfaces, Wheel & Paint Cleaner turns red in color indicating that the contaminants are dissolving. After 3-5 minutes simply rinse and then wash as usual.

Directions:

Consult SDS for complete safety information before using.

NOTE: Use in a well ventilated area. Product will turn red when dissolving metal particles. Do not allow product to dry on vehicle in sun.

For Wheels:

1. Wet entire wheel and surrounding area with water.
2. Liberally spray Wheel and Paint Cleaner directly on surface.
3. Allow product to dwell for 3 to 5 minutes. For Stubborn contamination, use soft brush or wash mitt to agitate the surface.
4. Rinse well with water

For paint body surfaces:

1. Thoroughly wash and rinse surfaces to remove loose dirt and contaminants.
2. Liberally spray Wheel and Paint Cleaner on area to be cleaned.
3. Allow product to dwell for 3 to 5 minutes. For stubborn contamination, use a soft brush or wash mitt to agitate the surface.
4. Wash as usual.

IF IN EYES: Flush immediately with large amounts of clean water for a minimum of 15 minutes, lifting upper and lower lids occasionally. Do not rub eyes. If any irritation persists seek medical attention.

IF ON SKIN: Remove/take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with water.

INHALATION: If breathing is difficult or irritating move person to fresh air immediately.

Storage: Do not store in direct sunlight. Keep container tightly closed and in cool, dry place. Keep from freezing.

Disposal: Dispose of in accordance with local/regional regulations.
